Endoscopy

Our Specialists provides patients with affordable endoscopic examination. Endoscopy is a short, simple and very common procedure that allows the specialist to observe the inside of the body without performing major surgery using a thin

lighted fiberscope known as the endoscope.

Upper endoscopy

Gastroscopy is the passage of the endoscope through the mouth into the stomach which allows the specialist to visually examine the lining of the oesophagus (gullet), stomach and duodenum (small bowel).

Colonoscopy is a procedure which allows the specialist to visually inspect the inside of the bowel by the insertion of the endoscpe through the back passage. This painless procedure allows sampling of the lining (biopsy) or removal of small tumours or polyps.

GDH patients are mainly referred by the GPs. However, wedo accept open access gastroscopy and colonoscopy. Following the procedure, the reports will be forwarded to the referring doctor at the end of the procedure. All patients returned to referring doctors for follow-up and management
